2 • Keep your prayers short so that others can also pray.
3 • Stay on the topic suggested by facilitator.
4 • Continue praying short prayers on the same topic until transition to next topic.

7 *[Letting God know why you love Him: His love; His forgiveness, etc.]*

9 Ps. 34:1-3 “I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my
10 mouth. My soul shall make its boast in the LORD; The humble shall hear of it and
11 be glad. Oh, magnify the LORD with me, And let us exalt His name together.”
12

13 “Prayer and praise offered to God by his believing children honor and glorify his
14 name.”—*Signs of the Times*, June 6, 1895

CONFESSION

16
17 *[Admitting mistakes in appropriate ways: “Forgive my temper,” etc.]*
18

19 Ps. 51:1-3 “Have mercy upon me, O God, According to Your lovingkindness;
20 According to the multitude of Your tender mercies, Blot out my transgressions. ...
21 For I acknowledge my transgressions, And my sin is always before me.”
22

23 Ps. 139:23,24 “Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my
24 anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way
25 everlasting.

27 1 John 1:9 “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and
28 to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

30 “With the confession of the repenting, believing sinner, Christ mingles His own

36 *[Thanking Him for His many blessings: “You gave me new job,” etc.]*

41 our Lord Jesus Christ...”

43 1 Thess. 5:18 “...in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ
44 Jesus for you.”

46 “We do not pray any too much, but we are too sparing of giving thanks. If the
47 loving-kindness of God called forth from our hearts more thanksgiving and praise,
48 we should have far more power in prayer.”—*Testimonies*, Vol. 5, 317.

50 SUPPLICATION

51 *[Making specific requests: “Please help with my finances,” relationships, etc..]*

52

53 Matt. 7:7,8 “Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it
54 will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and
55 to him who knocks it will be opened.”

56

57 1 John 5:14,15 “Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask
58 anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us,
59 whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.”

60

61 Matt. 18:19,20 “Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning
62 anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. “For where
63 two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.”

73 Ps. 103:8-11 “The LORD is merciful and gracious, Slow to anger, and
74 abounding in mercy. ⁹He will not always strive with us, Nor will He
75 keep His anger forever. ¹⁰He has not dealt with us according to our
76 sins, Nor punished us according to our iniquities. ¹¹For as the heavens
77 are high above the earth, So great is His mercy toward those who fear
78 Him;

82 Ps. 51:10 “Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast
83 spirit within me.”

85 Ezek. 36:25 “Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be

87 idols. ²⁶“I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I
88 will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of
