## Introduction

This is the first of a multi-part Bible study on the Godhead. Made up of three distinct Eternal Persons, the Godhead is revealed throughout the Old and New Testament Scriptures.

The Father is one of these distinct Eternal Persons. You will learn about Him in this first study. The next parts of this study present evidence on, (1) Christ, the Father's representative and self-existent Divine Saviour of the world; (2) the Holy Spirit, Christ's Representative and Successor; and the (3) "Eternal" Three, and "The LORD our God, the LORD is one." An addendum to the second part lists the many quotations of Ellen White attesting to the "everlasting to everlasting," eternal duration, of Christ's life.

Unless otherwise indicated, all Scriptures are taken from the KJV. In my personal study I use the NKJV for readability, but since this began as a study of Ellen White's writings, and she primarily used the KJV, I use the KJV version in most of this series of Bible studies.

I let the Scriptures speak for themselves, sharing limited commentary and a few relevant quotations..

Throughout the studies footnotes are added, bringing further clarification on the subject in question, or providing key quotations from the writings of Ellen G. White.

These studies are the result of three years of careful study of the Bible, the writings of Ellen White, and other authors on the subject. To date, more than 1,500 pages of quotations have been collected from the writings of Ellen White on the subject.

In these studies there is some duplication of texts.

Unless stated otherwise, quotations come from the writings of Mrs. White. The verses with asterisks (\*) indicate important references.

There are line numbers to help attendees more easily follow the presentation.

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# The Bible Study

## The Mysterious Godhead of the Father

1 The works of creation prove the existence, glory, wisdom  
2 and power of the Godhead.

9 even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse.”

10 The Godhead is a mystery.<sup>1</sup>

12 the Almighty unto perfection? 8 It is as high as heaven; what canst  
13 thou do? deeper than hell; what canst thou know? 9 The measure  
14 thereof is longer than the earth, and broader than the sea.”

16 God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our  
17 children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law.”

18 The Father is one of three Persons who make up the  
19 Godhead.<sup>2</sup>

## 23 *The Personhood of the Father*

24 The Father is a person and distinct from Christ.

25 John 4:34 “Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that  
26 sent me, and to finish his work.”

27 \*Matthew 6:9 “After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which  
28 art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.”

29 \*John 12:49-50 “For I have not spoken of myself; but the Father  
30 which sent me, he gave me a commandment, what I should say, and  
31 what I should speak. 50 And I know that his commandment is life  
32 everlasting: whatsoever I speak therefore, even as the Father said unto  
33 me, so I speak.”

34 Matthew 11:25-26 “At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee,  
35 O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things  
36 from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes. 26

## 40 *Some Attributes of the Father*

41 The Father is eternal.

42 Genesis 21:33 “And Abraham planted a grove in Beersheba, and  
43 called there on the name of the LORD, the everlasting God.”

44 \*Deuteronomy 33:27 “The eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath  
45 are the everlasting arms.”

46 \*Psalms 90:2 Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou  
47 hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to

58 which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can

60 The Father is great in His majesty and above all Gods.

61 Psalms 93:1 “The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty.”

74 The Father is unchanging (immutable).

77 and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no  
78 variableness, neither shadow of turning.”

79 The Father is present everywhere (omnipresent).

80 \*Psalms 11:4 “The Lord is in his holy temple, the Lord's throne is in  
81 heaven: his eyes behold, his eyelids try, the children of men.”

82 \*Psalms 139:7-10 “Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall  
83 I flee from thy presence? 8 If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if  
84 I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. 9 If I take the wings of  
85 the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; 10 Even there  
86 shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me.”

87 The Father is all powerful (omnipotent).

93 shall be with the beasts of the field, and they shall make thee to eat  
94 grass as oxen, and they shall wet thee with the dew of heaven, and  
95 seven times shall pass over thee, till thou know that the most High  
96 ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will. ...  
97 35 ‘And all the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing: and he  
98 doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and among the  
99 inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay his hand, or say unto him,

110 Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the  
111 things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will  
112 do all my pleasure.”

113 Jeremiah 17:10 “I the Lord search the heart, I try the reins, even to  
114 give every man according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his

#### 116 The Father is Wise<sup>4</sup>

117 Job 12:13 “With him is wisdom and strength, he hath counsel and

120 everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth,  
121 fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his  
122 understanding.”

124 God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his: 21 And he  
125 changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up

128 knoweth what is in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him.”

167 that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live  
168 through him.”

169 The Father is merciful.

170 \*Exodus 34:6-7 “And the Lord passed by before him, and proclaimed,  
171 The Lord, The Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and  
172 abundant in goodness and truth, 7 Keeping mercy for thousands,  
173 forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means  
174 clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children,  
175 and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth  
176 generation.”

177 \*Psalms 103:11 “For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is  
178 his mercy toward them that fear him.”

194 and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he  
195 retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy. 19 He  
196 will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our  
197 iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.”

198 Jeremiah 31:34 “And they shall teach no more every man his  
199 neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for  
200 they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of  
201 them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will  
202 remember their sin no more.”

213 The Father is good.

215 and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at  
216 all.”

217 Matthew 19:17 “And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good?  
218 there is none good but one, that is, God.”  
219 James 1:17 “Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and  
220 cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness,  
221 neither shadow of turning.”  
222 The Father judges.<sup>5</sup>  
223 Genesis 18:25 “Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?”  
224 \*Psalms 82:8 “Arise, O God, judge the earth: for thou shalt inherit all  
225 nations.”  
226 2 Chronicles 20:12 “O our God, wilt thou not judge them? for we have  
227 no might against this great company that cometh against us; neither

## 229 *Father Represented Himself Through Christ*

230 No Person has ever seen God.  
231 Exodus 33:20 “And he said, Thou canst not see my face: for there  
232 shall no man see me, and live.”  
233 \*John 1:18 “No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten  
234 Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.”  
235 1 Timothy 6:15-16 “Which in his times he shall shew, who is the  
236 blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords; 16  
237 Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can  
238 approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be  
239 honour and power everlasting. Amen.”  
240 The Father represented Himself through Christ.<sup>6</sup>

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5. God’s necessary work of judgment is seen in a variety of situations, including Adam and Eve (Genesis 3), the corrupt world of Noah’s day (Genesis 6-8), Sodom and Gomorrah (Genesis 18-19), the Egyptian oppressors with plagues (Genesis 15:14; Genesis 7-12), the Israelites when they worshipped the golden calf (Exodus 32:26-35), Achan (Joshua 7), foreign rulers like Nebuchadnezzar and Belshazzar (Daniel 4 and 5), and in the New Testament on various individuals (Herod, Ananias and Sapphira, Elymas etc.).

## 267 *The Father and Creation*

268 The Father was involved in creation.

269 Genesis 1:1 “In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.”

280 made thee, and established thee?”

281 Isaiah 63:16 “Doubtless thou art our father, though Abraham be  
282 ignorant of us, and Israel acknowledge us not: thou, O Lord, art our  
283 father, our redeemer; thy name is from everlasting.”

284 Matthew 5:16 “Let your light so shine before men, that they may see  
285 your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.”

286 \*Matthew 6:9 “After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which  
287 art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.”

288 Matthew 7:11 “If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts  
289 unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in  
290 heaven give good things to them that ask him?”

291 John 5:30 “I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and  
292 my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of  
293 the Father which hath sent me.”

301 Deuteronomy 32:19 “And when the Lord saw it, he abhorred them,

307 *The Father's Love for Humankind*

308 The Father sought to be in relationship with humankind.

309 \*Genesis 1:26 “And God said, Let us make man in our image, after  
310 our likeness.”

311 Exodus 25:8 “And let them make me a sanctuary; that I may dwell  
312 among them.”

313 Deuteronomy 7:7-8 “The Lord did not set his love upon you, nor  
314 choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye  
315 were the fewest of all people: 8 But because the Lord loved you, and  
316 because he would keep the oath which he had sworn unto your fathers,

343 earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud: 15 And I will remember  
344 my covenant, which is between me and you and every living creature

349 land that I will shew thee: 2 And I will make of thee a great nation,  
350 and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a  
351 blessing: 3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that  
352 curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.”

353 \*Jeremiah 31:33 “But this shall be the covenant that I will make with  
354 the house of Israel; After those days, saith the Lord, I will put my law  
355 in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God,  
356 and they shall be my people.”

357 \*Hebrews 8:10 “For this is the covenant that I will make with the  
358 house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into  
359 their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God,  
360 and they shall be to me a people.”

361 **The Father commands our worship.**

362 \*Exodus 20:3-6 “Thou shalt have no other gods before me. 4 Thou  
363 shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any  
364 thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is  
365 in the water under the earth.”

366 Exodus 34:14 “For thou shalt worship no other god: for the Lord,  
367 whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God.”

368 Deuteronomy 5:29 “O that there were such an heart in them, that they  
369 would fear me, and keep all my commandments always, that it might  
370 be well with them, and with their children for ever!”

371 \*Deuteronomy 6:5 “And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all



372 thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.”  
373 Deuteronomy 10:20-21 “Thou shalt fear the Lord thy God; him shalt  
374 thou serve, and to him shalt thou cleave, and swear by his name. 21  
375 He is thy praise, and he is thy God, that hath done for thee these great  
376 and terrible things, which thine eyes have seen.”

377 *Respond*

378 Reason with God.

379 Isaiah 1:18 Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD:  
380 though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though  
381 they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.”

382 Return to God.

383 Isaiah 44:21-22 (KJV) 21 Remember these, O Jacob and Israel; for  
384 thou art my servant: I have formed thee; thou art my servant: O Israel,  
385 thou shalt not be forgotten of me. 22 I have blotted out, as a thick  
386 cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins: return unto me; for  
387 I have redeemed thee”

388 Isaiah 51:11 “Therefore the redeemed of the LORD shall return, and  
389 come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their  
390 head: they shall obtain gladness and joy; and sorrow and mourning  
391 shall flee away.”

392 Jeremiah 24:7 “And I will give them an heart to know me, that I am  
393 the LORD: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for  
394 they shall return unto me with their whole heart.”

395 Anticipate a new life.

396 Jeremiah 31:33 “But this shall be the covenant that I will make with  
397 the house of Israel; After those days, saith the Lord, I will put my law  
398 in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God,  
399 and they shall be my people.”

400 Ezekiel 11:19-20 “And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new  
401 spirit within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and  
402 will give them an heart of flesh: 20 That they may walk in my statutes,  
403 and keep mine ordinances, and do them: and they shall be my people,  
404 and I will be their God.

405 “Ezekiel 36:25-27 “Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye  
406 shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I  
407 cleanse you. 26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will  
408 I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh,  
409 and I will give you an heart of flesh. 27 And I will put my spirit within  
410 you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judg-  
411 ments, and do them.

412 Commit to an ongoing relationship with God.

413 Revelation 3:20 “Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man  
414 hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup  
415 with him, and he with me.”

## 416 *A Few Quotations*

417 God always has been.

418 “God always has been. He is the great I AM. The psalmist declares,  
419 ‘Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever Thou hadst formed  
420 the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting Thou art  
421 God.’ [Psalm 90:2.] He is the high and lofty One that inhabiteth  
422 eternity. ‘I am the Lord, I change not,’ He declares. [Isaiah 57:15;  
423 Malachi 3:6.] With Him there is no variableness, neither shadow of  
424 turning. He is ‘the same yesterday, today, and forever.’ [James 1:17;  
425 Hebrews 13:8.] He is infinite and omnipresent. No words of ours can  
426 describe His greatness and majesty.” Manuscript 132, 1903.35.

427 The Father cannot be fully understood.

428 “We can never by searching find out God. He does not lay open his  
429 plans to prying, inquisitive minds. We must not attempt to lift with  
430 presumptuous hand the curtain behind which he veils his majesty. ...  
431 No mortal mind can penetrate the secrecy in which the Mighty One  
432 dwells and works. We can comprehend no more of his dealings with  
433 us and the motives that actuate him than he sees fit to reveal. He  
434 orders everything in righteousness, and we are not to be dissatisfied  
435 and distrustful, but to bow in reverent submission. He will reveal to us  
436 as much of his purposes as it is for our good to know; and beyond that  
437 we must trust the hand that is omnipotent, the heart that is full of  
438 love.” *Review and Herald*, April 7, 1885, par. 12.

439 The Father is a person.  
440 “God is a spirit; yet He is a personal being, for man was made in His  
441 image. As a personal being, God has revealed Himself in His Son.  
442 Jesus, the outshining of the Father’s glory, “and the express image of  
443 His person” (Hebrews 1:3), was on earth found in fashion as a man.”  
444 *Education*, 131.6.

445 The Father represented Himself through Christ.  
446 “Christ, the outshining of the Father’s glory, came to the world as its  
447 light. He came to represent God to men, and of Him it is written that  
448 He was anointed ‘with the Holy Ghost and with power,’ and ‘went  
449 about doing good.’ Acts 10:38.” *Christ's Object Lessons*, 416.2.

450 The Father revealed His Love through Christ.  
451 “The atonement of Christ was not made in order to induce God to love  
452 those whom he otherwise hated; it was not made to produce a love that  
453 was not in existence; but it was made as a manifestation of the love  
454 that was already in God’s heart, an exponent of the divine favor in the  
455 sight of heavenly intelligences, in the sight of worlds unfallen, and in  
456 the sight of a fallen race.” *Signs of the Times*, May 30, 1895, par. 6.

457 The Father suffered and gave Himself with Christ.  
458 “Christ submitted to crucifixion, although the heavenly host could  
459 have delivered Him. The angels suffered with Christ. God Himself  
460 was crucified with Christ; for Christ was one with the Father.” *Bible*  
461 *Echo*, August 6, 1894, par. 5.

462 “That this redemption might be ours, God withheld not even the  
463 sacrifice of Himself. He gave Himself in His Son. The Father suffered  
464 with Christ in all His humiliation and agony. He suffered as He saw  
465 the Son of His love despised and rejected by those whom He came to  
466 elevate, ennoble, and save. He saw Him hanging upon the cross,  
467 mocked and jeered at by the passers by, and He hid as it were His face  
468 from Him. He saw Christ bearing the sin of the world and dying in the  
469 sinner’s stead.” Manuscript 21, 1900.11.

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
