- 86 constant doing of God's will in daily life which gives prayer its po-
- 87 tency, as our Lord plainly taught: "Not every one which saith unto
- 88 Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven, but he that
- 89 doeth the will of My Father which is in heaven." E. M. Bounds, *The*

- 95 James 1:5 (NKJV) 5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God
- 96 ... and it will be given to him.

- 97 "In the place of bearing your perplexities to a brother or a minister,
- 98 take them to the Lord in prayer. Do not place the minister where God
- 99 should be ... It is right, always, to counsel together. It is right to con-
- 100 verse together. It is right to make the difficulties that present them-
- 101 selves in any enterprise plain before your brethren and your minister.
- 102 But do not so greatly dishonor God as to depend on man for wisdom.

- 111 Ask With Thanksgiving.
- 112 Php. 4: 6,7 "...but in everything by prayer and supplication, with
- 113 thanksgiving...."
- 114 Eph. 5:20 "...giving thanks always for all things to God..."
- 115 1 Thess. 5:18 "...in everything give thanks; for this is the will of
- 116 God in Christ Jesus for you."
- 117 Php. 4:4 "Rejoice in the Lord always: and again I say, Rejoice."
- 118 "If the loving-kindness of God called forth more thanksgiving and
- 119 praise, we would have far more power in prayer. We would abound
- more and more in the love of God and have more bestowed to praise
